Ann (Faulkner) Upshaw would've been about 85-90 years old in 1860, which sounds more like "Old Mrs. Upshaw"). It would be vital to know the age of the letter-writer, J.H. Curry, when he wrote the letter. His own age would have a great effect on his reference point to someone as "old", whether he were a teenager or in his mid-fifties, for example.

Our brother's life and conversation leave no grounds to doubt but that he is now sleeping in Jesus.

"Uncle Adkin", as he was familiarly called, was born in Virginia but moved to Georgia when he was about 8 years of age. When about 35 years of age, he moved to Coweta (County) where his family was raised. In 1863 he moved to Heard County and in 1865 to this County to the place where he died.

The deceased was one of the leading members of the Primitive Baptist Church, in the faith of which he died. To the many relatives and friends in the County we extend our condolence.
